

Advocacy Digest | April 22, 2025 Brad Boycks, Executive Director



Thank You for a Successful Advocacy Day!

We want to extend a huge thank you to everyone who joined us for Advocacy Day in early April—our first such event since 2019!

This year, we welcomed over 70 members from 11 local home builders associations who participated in nearly 50 meetings with State Assembly and State Senate members. These meetings engaged lawmakers on both sides of the political aisle and helped amplify the voice of our industry.

Our first panel featured two respected political consultants—one Democrat, one Republican—who offered valuable insight into the recent Wisconsin Supreme Court race and a forward-looking view on the 2026 elections.

We were also honored to host a legislative leadership panel featuring:

- Speaker Robin Vos
- Assembly Minority Leader Greta Neubauer
- State Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu
- State Senate Minority Leader Dianne Hesselbein

Thanks again to all who made the day a success. We look forward to gathering again for the next Advocacy Day in early 2027!

WHEDA Loan Improvement Bill Gains Momentum

One of the key issues discussed during Advocacy Day is already moving forward in the Legislature.

Senate Bill 180, which proposes key improvements to three WHEDA loan programs, was recently introduced and received a public hearing on April 17. This bill would allow developers to combine municipal TIF support with loans under the following programs:

- Infrastructure Access Program
- Restore Main Street Program
- Vacancy to Vitality Program

With bipartisan backing and 43 coauthors, SB 180 is making strong progress. Its companion legislation, Assembly Bill 194, has also been introduced, and we are now awaiting a public hearing in the Assembly Committee on Housing and Real Estate.

This is a major step forward in supporting workforce housing development across Wisconsin.

WBA Files Amicus Brief in Landmark Rental Housing Case

The WBA Executive Committee recently approved funding to file an amicus brief in a significant case impacting rental housing in Wisconsin.

In Koble Investments v. Marquardt, the Wisconsin Court of Appeals ruled that a

landlord using a lease missing a required domestic violence protection notice cannot enforce the lease—and must refund twice the total rent paid, even if the tenant received full housing services.

For example, if rent was \$1,000/month for a year, the landlord could owe \$24,000.

This precedent could create a serious chilling effect for small multifamily housing development. That's why WBA is working with Attorney Robert Procter to submit an amicus brief to the Wisconsin Supreme Court.

WBA is committed to protecting the rights of builders, developers, and housing providers across the state.
